Knowing what we want  
Mark 10:46-52

Last week we personalized the question that Jesus asked to a paralytic man, “Do you want to get well?” Today we will take a look at another question that Jesus asked a man that was blind, “What do you want me to do for you?” Today we will ponder this question as if Jesus were asking it to each of us. We will take a look at what led to Jesus asking this question and see what prompted this blind man to approach Christ with such boldness.

Why did the blind man approach Christ?

- 1 – There was a need in his life.
- 2 – He truly believed Jesus would help him.
- 3 – He wanted to do what he could not do without Christ.

How did he approach Christ?

- 1 – He called Jesus’ name
- 2 – He did not let others stop him
- 3 – He accepted what Jesus said
- 4 – He asked Jesus for what he needed.
